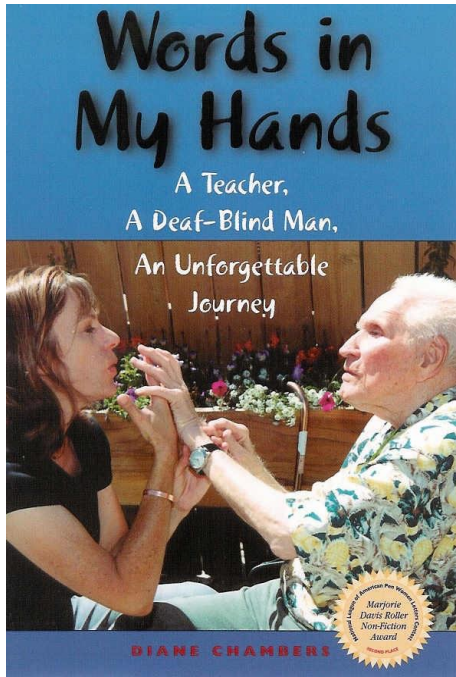


Words in My Hands
